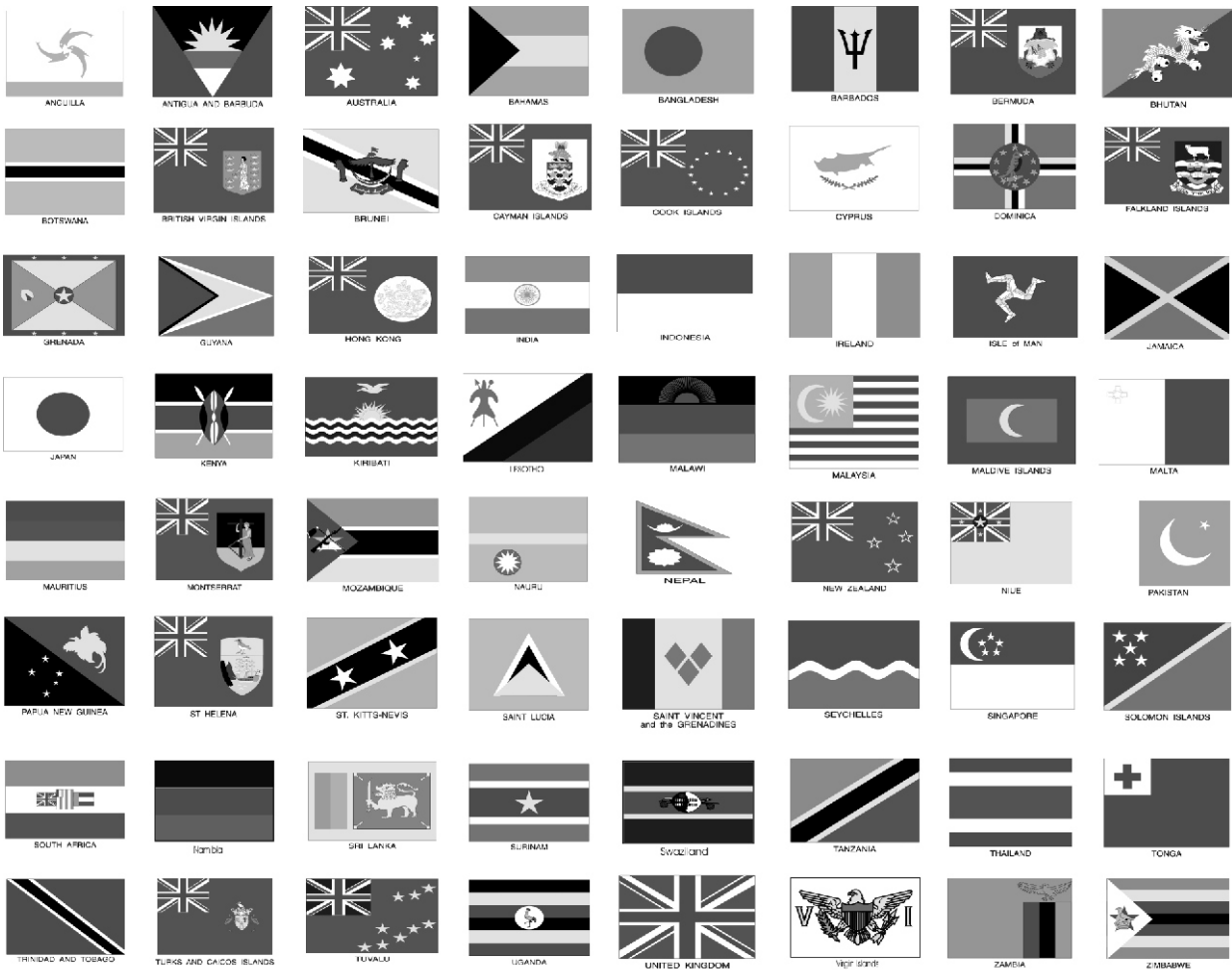


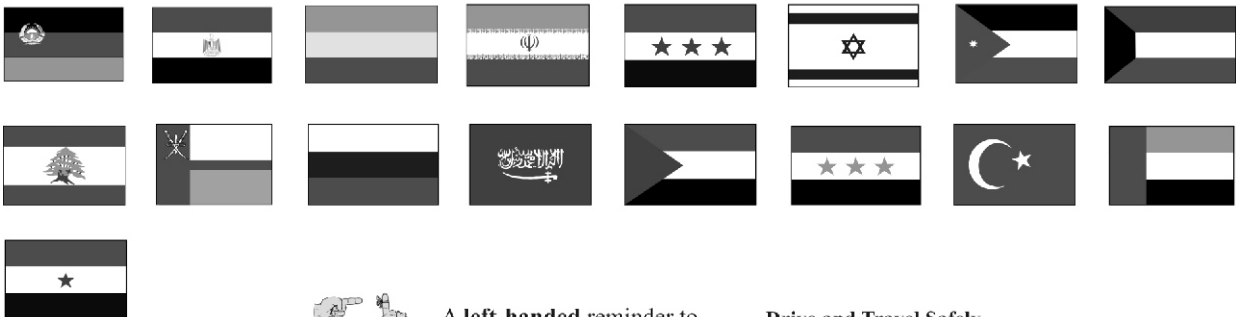
Countries That drive on the LEFT



Approximately 33% (one third) of the worlds population drives on the LEFT side of the road.

While only 15% of ALL vehicles turn left, 45% of auto collisions,
and 31% of pedestrian accidents involve a **left** turning vehicle.

When travelling, respect the country you are in. Not all countries hold **left-handers** in high regard, and the price to pay for ignoring a countries' belief, is NOT worth the trouble, so avoid the constant and obvious use of your left hand in the following 17 countries: **Afghanistan, Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Oman, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syria, Turkey, United Arab Emirates (U.A.E.), Yemen .**



A **left-handed** reminder to ... **Drive and Travel Safely**
